Acquisition of English as a Second Language (course)

Course structure:

- 1. An introduction into research design and research infrastructures and techniques
- 2. In parallel:
 - Reading critically and discussing in class published research studies
 - Designing and conducting a small-scale experimental study in pairs

Assessment and evaluation:

- Test (30%)
- Two oral presentations (20%)
- Research report (50%)
